CSMLA Muzzle Loader of the Year Criteria

Each element is rated 0 to 5. Zero means no supporting documentation;
Five represents excellent documentation to support your nominee.

1. Contributions to muzzle loading
 - A. Educational clinics or seminars
 - B. Literary contributions
 - C. Programs or events developed and/or involved with
 - D. Evidence of commitment and accomplishment
 - E. Leadership abilities
 - F. Special accomplishments
2. Membership in muzzle loading organizations
 - A. Number of muzzle loading organizations in which the candidate participates
 - B. Length and continuity of membership in each organization
 - C. Office(s) held
 - D. Evidence of commitment and accomplishments
3. Sportsmanship
 - A. Peer respect
 - B. Conduct afield
 - C. Conduct at muzzle loading events
 - D. Number of years as a muzzleloader
 - E. Support of wildlife conservation programs
 - F. Promotion of sportsmanship
4. Animals taken with a muzzleloader
5. Shooting awards won with a muzzleloader
 - A. Awards won with in Colorado
 - B. Awards won outside Colorado
6. Muzzle loading era skills (include firearm building, tanning, etc.)
 - A. Awards won
 - B. Quantity
 - C. Other evidence of accomplishment
7.
 - A. Muzzle loading firearms collected
 - B. Awards won
 - C. Other evidence of recognition

NOTE: Candidates for Muzzle Loader of the Year do not have to meet all of the criteria as defined. Your letter of explanation of their participation and support of the muzzle loading sport and all of its attributes will be the information that the judges use to make a determination. If there is someone you feel would be a good candidate, talk with them and find out what they can do to provide to help support your nomination. The nomination does not have to be a secret.
